**YORK, Pa. (June 17, 2013)** – National Dump the Pump day is Thursday, June 20, 2013. This national day of awareness focuses on the benefits of using alternative forms of transportation as opposed to driving alone, such as decreasing fuel dependency, minimizing congestion and saving money on gas, maintenance, insurance, parking and reducing your carbon footprint. Commuters can Dump the Pump by taking public transit, biking, carpooling, vanpooling, walking, or teleworking.

Commuter Services of Pennsylvania is holding a contest to celebrate Dump the Pump day. Commuters are encouraged to submit their story, in 250 words or less, about how they have saved money and/or improved their quality of life when they 'Dumped the Pump' by using a non-single occupancy vehicle commuting mode. The winner will be selected by a panel of judges comprised of the Commuter Services Board of Directors and staff. They will win a Smart Commuter Prize Pack valued at \$50, including a \$25 gift card, and have their photo and story featured on the website. Smaller prizes (valued at \$15) will also be awarded to two additional winners.
