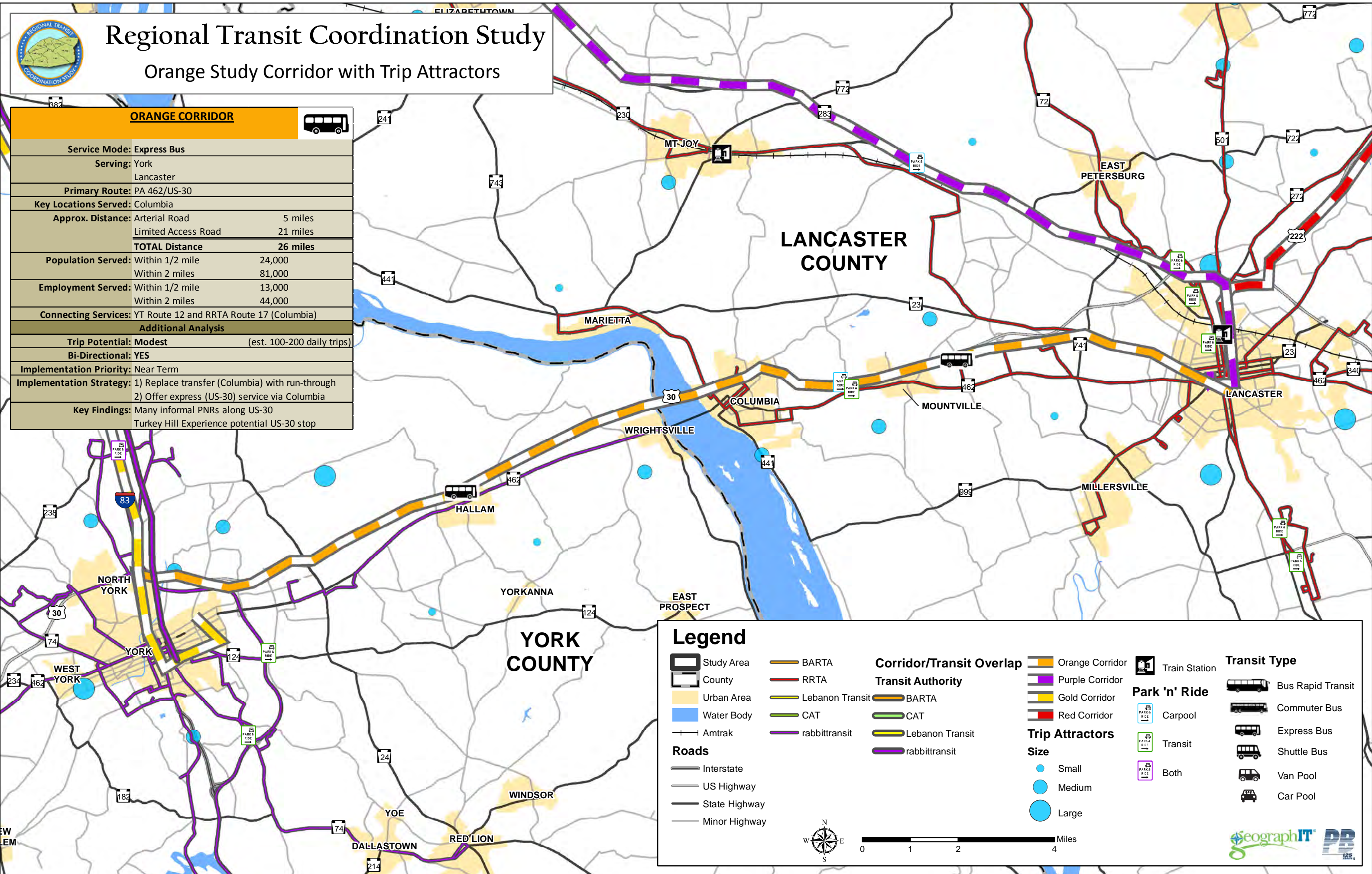

Implementation Strategy:	1) Replace transfer (Columbia) with run-through 2) Offer express (US-30) service via Columbia
Key Findings:	Many informal PNRs along US-30 Turkey Hill Experience potential US-30 stop
