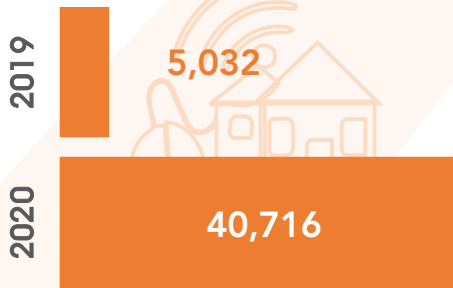

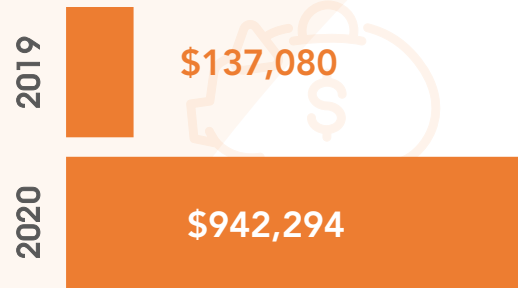
# TELECOMMUTING CONTINUES TO GROW IN 2020!

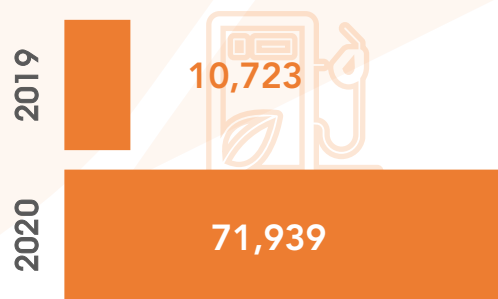
## Telecommute Trips



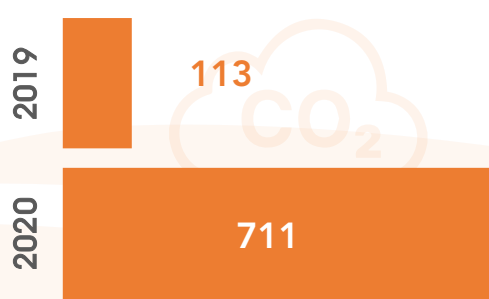
## Money Saved

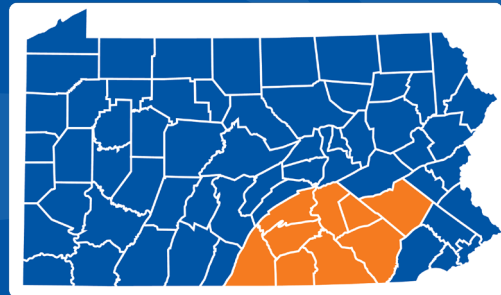
