

## Walk Bike Bus

During the month of September, we teamed up with the City of York Bureau of Health to promote Walk, Bike, Bus York and encourage commuters to walk, bike or ride rabbittransit as their transportation mode. Commuters recorded **295 green trips, with 4,454 miles not driven and 3,884 tons of CO2 reduced** for the month. Meanwhile, they **saved \$2,784, 198 gallons of gas and burned 7,857 calories!** Thank you to everyone who participated!

We celebrated our **College Month** promotion during October and asked students, faculty and staff to use a green commute! Congratulations to **Franklin & Marshall College** for having the most Commute PA green trips, with 655, for the second year in a row! Greatly appreciate **Gettysburg College (99 green trips)**, **Harrisburg University of Science and Technology (94 green trips)**, **Shippensburg University (56 green trips)** and **Albright College (52 green trips)** for participating and promoting our services.



For two weeks in November, we pitted the local County Governments against each other in a friendly competition to record the most green trips during that span.
