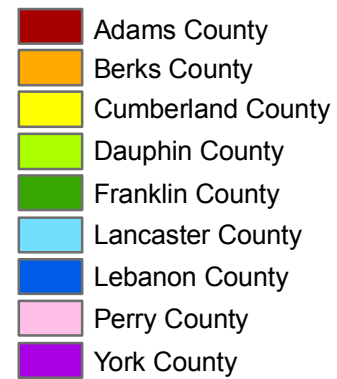




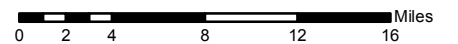
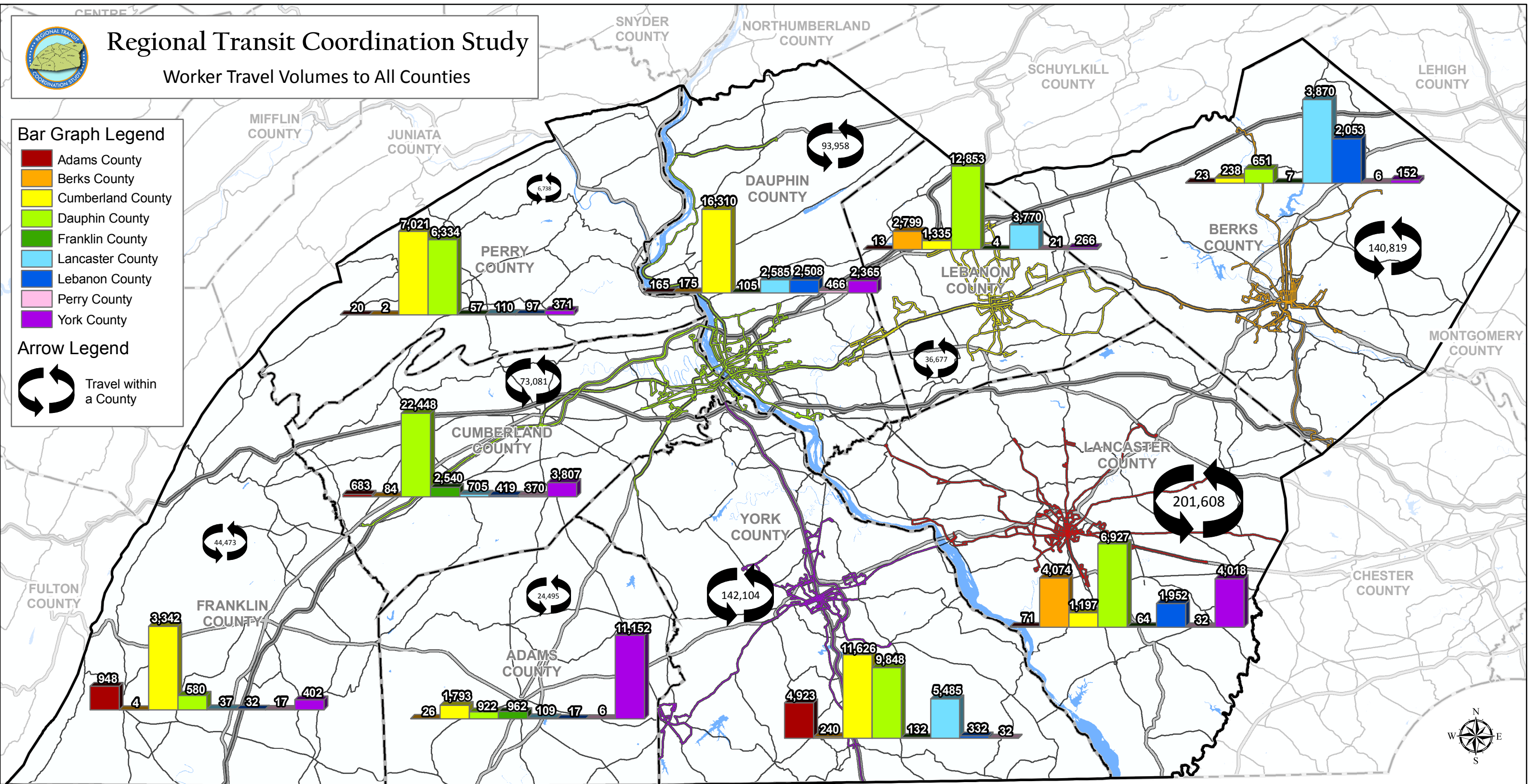

Worker Travel Volumes to All Counties

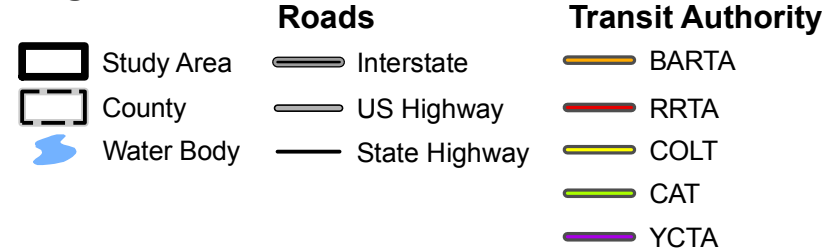

- Portions of this map were generated from the sources listed to the right.
- The totals displayed on the bars of the graphs were calculated using the Worker Flow Files from the U.S. Census Bureau for the 2000 Census.
- The bars are color-coded to represent each county in the study area.
- The totals on each bar represent the total number people traveling to work from the graph's county to the county represented by the color.
- Each value in the circular black arrows represents the number of people living and traveling to work in that county.
